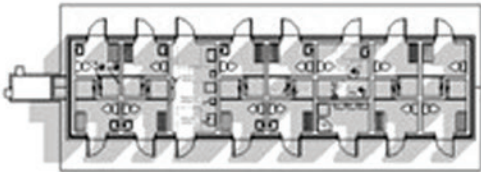


ROY GRINDSTAFF SKILLED TRADES CENTER COMPLETED

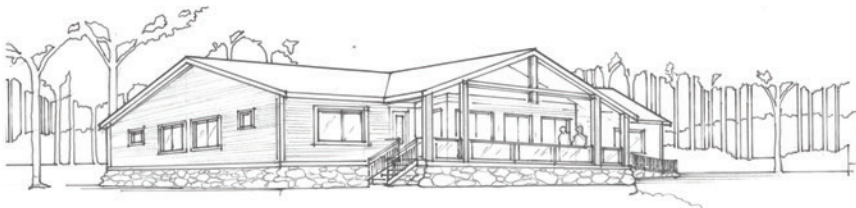

Efforts are underway to raise \$8 million to start construction immediately following summer camp 2024. The \$8 million includes \$2 million in new commitments, \$2 million from conservation easement at Parish Reservation, and a \$4 million community investment tax credit program loan at Wall Street Journal Prime minus 4%.
