



NRA Basic Range Safety Officer Course

PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED, LIMITED CLASS SIZE

Class is limited to registered BSA adult leaders, age 21 and older. This class will be limited to the first 12 candidates that register [HERE](#) with payment. **Course fee \$75.00.**

This includes, RSO student study guide, a basic firearm training program brochure, an NRA Gun Safety Rules *Brochure*, course completion certificate, and RSO patch. A light breakfast and Lunch is provided. Portions of this training are outside, please dress accordingly.

Registration Process:

Pre-registration, NO walk-ons. Payment due day of training, and will be collected at check-in.

Objective: To develop NRA Certified Range Safety Officers with the knowledge, skills, and attitude essential to organizing, conducting, and supervising safe shooting activities and range operations.

Range Safety Officer (RSO) candidates will learn roles and responsibilities of an **RSO**; Range *Standard Operating Procedures* (SOPs); range inspection; range rules; range briefings; emergency procedures; and firearm stoppages and malfunctions.

*Students must pass final exam with 90% or higher score and are responsible for contacting the Council Camping Department with your NRA Certificate. All first time instructors, Coaches, and Range Safety Officers pay a flat NRA credentialing fee of \$50 for a 2 year term. ** NRA Members credentialing fees are \$30 for a 2 year term.*

Instructor: NRA Training Counselor/NRA Chief Range Safety Officer, assisted by other NRA Range Safety Officers.
