WA-HI-NASA LODGE GIFT NAMES PROGRAM DECK

The Wa-Hi-Nasa Lodge wanted to contribute to a program-related project as part of the Council's Campaign for Boxwell Reservation. Council Executive Board member and Lodge Advisor, Craig Salazar, worked with Scout Executive, Larry Brown, to find an appropriate way to show the support of the Wa-Hi-Nasa Lodge to Boxwell and the Council. The new Leadership Center and dining hall at Camp Stahlman has been designed to include a program deck at the back of the facility. The Lodge decided to commit to a pledge of \$75,000 to name the deck and provide an opportunity to share their history with Scouts and visitors. They expected the funds to be raised over a three to four-year period with a combination of Order of the Arrow (OA) member contributions and the sale of patches. Craig shared, "We were overwhelmed with the generosity of our members who wanted to support the campaign as part of the Lodge gift. We reached our goal within a month." Through a generous matching gift made by anonymous donor the OA exceeded their goal by 75%. The donor made the gift to honor the memory of John M. Green, long-time Scouter who passed away in 2019.

Craig shared that "The Wa-Hi-Nasa Lodge has been a part of the Middle Tennessee Council for more than 80 years. This was just one more way for the Lodge and its members to support the Council."

According to the Wa-Hi-Nasa website, "the Lodge was founded in 1938 and has had a long and rich history of serving Scouting within the Middle Tennessee area. From a humble beginning when eight Scouts were inducted into the Order of the Arrow at Narrows of the Harpeth Old Boxwell, the Lodge has grown into an organization with a regular yearly membership of over one thousand members that continues to provide significant service to the Middle Tennessee Council and beyond."

"We are grateful for the strong partnership we have with the Wa-Hi-Nasa Lodge," said Larry Brown. "In addition to this generous support the Lodge has overseen our Winter Camp Program for years. Their tireless work on behalf of our youth is outstanding and shows their commitment to living out the values of the Scout Oath and Law."
